



Collaborating to Create Conservation Impact

Our effective partnerships, results-focused administration, and strategic goals have led to these significant accomplishments:

Financial Support for Partners:

Our collaborative grant recruitment and management resulted in more than \$2M in financial support for our program partners in 14 states

Coral Rescue and Propagation:

We are caring for nearly 3,000 rescued corals, propagating millions of offspring for reef restoration, and safeguarding hundreds of threatened and endangered corals .

Scientific Advancement:

Our working groups are advancing coral science in husbandry, biobanking, reproduction, and coral health

Public Awareness & Policy Influence:

Free climate communication workshops and social science strengthen our ability to inspire action. Publications advance coral science, raise awareness, and inform policy

Capacity Building:

Now in its third year, our coral aquarist program, the world's first such training course, is developing the next generation of coral aquarists and restoration practitioners.

Coral Champion (AZA and non-AZA members)	>/=\$20,000	At least a Coral Fan level monetary contribution + a staff member on the SAFE Coral program Steering Committee or host/sponsor a program workshop.	Coral Hero level benefits; promote partner coral conservation efforts on SAFECORAL.org Partner Projects page, and a Featured Social Media Collaboration with AZA during May through September; partnership plaque.
